# - Clothing Orders:

# - New Training Location (Band & Marksmanship) :

We have a budget of approximately \$3,000 for Marksmanship put aside this year for costs of halls and storage;

- Eric will find out on Nov 18 if the Knights of Columbus will be providing a hall for \$100 a week;

- Martin suggested that French schools or the Richelieu Community Centre be considered as potential locations (although Danusia mentioned not liking the idea of having guns in schools or the image of); Martin also suggested sending a letter to all parents by email to find a location for marksmanship;

-Cpt. Warden also mentioned finding a location for the Band's location which is also an issue.

# 7. Budget 2016-17

- All in favor that an amount of \$250 be approved for the Walkathon for the squadron with the most earned funds;

- Anabella raised a motion and all in favor to change the activity of the Laser Quest as it was unpopular with the Cadets and to be replaced with Archery Tag with an upcoming date to be determined;

- Eric will be contacting l'Amicale de la 500 for Camp Cadou and follow-up with Anne (Treasurer) as to what exactly the military requires; we owe approximately \$5,000 for the two events covering last spring and this Fall;

- An amount of \$1,500 to be allocated for music, band, location and equipment and we need to allocate a budget and ask the military for instruments; we also need to verify the storage upcoming invoice.

-To be discussed at our next meeting (however our spending for the Budget forecast is approximately \$47,500 leaving with an approximate amount of \$5,500 Extra funds).

-Squadron 75<sup>th</sup> Dinner and Dance for Christmas to be held on Friday, Dec 16, 2016 at 6:00 P.M. till 11:30 p.m. at the Eastview Legion, 294 Cyr Avenue in Vanier.
