ORDER OF DRESS FOR THE EXERCISE

- 1. The following is a list of equipment each cadet will be required to bring on the outing. Please note that most of the activities will be outside in cold and/or wet weather.
- 2. **Personal Clothing**. In addition to basic clothing worn by the individuals:
 - a. Signed Parents/Tutor Authorization Form (Mandatory)
 - b. Medical Insurance Card or photocopy (Mandatory)
 - c. Toque or hat (Mandatory)
 - d. Rain gear (top and bottom) (Mandatory)
 - e. Sleeping bag (Mandatory)
 - f. Scarf
 - g. Coat
 - h. Long legged pants (2 pairs) Jeans are not recommended
 - i. Warm sweater (preferably wool)
 - j. Shirt or sweater
 - k. Work gloves (one pair)
 - I. Socks (at least 3 pairs)
 - m. Rubber boots (Mandatory)
 - n. Boots (2nd pair) (must be at least water resistant. <u>Combat boots are acceptable as a second pair of footwear only</u>
 - o. T-shirts (at least 2)
 - p. Sweatshirt (Hoodie)
 - q. Underwear (at least 2 changes)
 - r. Pyjamas
 - s. Flashlight
 - t. Unbreakable plate, soup bowl, and cup
 - u. Utensils (knife, fork and spoon)
 - v. Personal medication (as required)

- w. Personal hygiene kit
- x. Sunglasses (optional)
- y. Sunscreen
- z. Lip balm
- aa. Mosquito Face Net
- 3. Level 4 cadets will bring a Field Message Pad or other small notebook, pencils (no pens) and plan on being able to carry all their personal belongings over a distance of 5 kilometres.
- 4. Cadets not wearing the appropriate clothing will not leave for the exercise and will be sent home.
- 5. Personal belongings will be identified. The squadron will not be held responsible for lost or stolen items.
- 6. All valuable objects such as expensive watches or jewellery, Walkman, CD, or audio players, as well as phones, should be left at home.
- 7. All delicacies (chocolates, candies, potato chips, etc.), as well as matches, lighters, knives and axes are forbidden.
- 8. Cadets that have a requirement to take medicine during the exercise will inform the Ex Admin O.
- 9. If a cadet has an illness, such as diabetes, epilepsy, infections or allergies, he/she must advise the Ex Admin O so that proper action can be taken in case of an emergency.
- 10. Field Training Uniform is acceptable BUT layers are recommended, and an overcoat is strongly suggested.
- 11. Everything must be placed in a waterproof container of some sort (plastic garbage bag) to avoid items getting wet in inclement weather. <u>Do not just pack equipment in a garbage bag, it will rip open.</u>
